<b>Credits</b>	There are 3 core courses of 2.5 credit & 2 core courses of 1.25 credit each in term-IV, V & VI and rest are the electives equal to 2.5 credits each. The number of class hours is 25 hours per core course and 25 hours per elective course. However, the incoming exchange students may take fewer credits/courses as per their requirement. We request you to verify the necessary course/credit requirement with your home university.

<b>Accommodation</b>	The Institute will provide compulsory residential facilities on its premises. Separate hostels for men and women. Students are not required to look for off campus accommodation. However, the students would have to pay the amount as per the IMT rules. Details of which are given below
<b>Approximate Expenses (Per Term)</b>	Housing and Food is provided on the IMT campus to all foreign students. A compulsory fee of INR 70,000/- [Single/Twin sharing (subject to availability) AC hostel accommodation with individual toilet] or INR 55,000/- [Twin sharing Non-AC hostel accommodation with common toilet] is payable by foreign students at the international Relations Office. This fee must be paid in cash, within 15 days of arrival on campus.
<b>Meal Plan</b>	The student's hostel has a mess within the campus which provides four meals a day for all the students at IMT. The campus also has an excellent canteen and cafeteria where a variety of food and beverages are available round the clock.
<b>Medical Facilities</b>	A doctor is available on the campus throughout. The doctor provides the Prescription and some medicines, however other medicines and the prescribed medical tests have to be taken care of by the students.
<b>Visa Requirements</b>	It is mandatory for all exchange students to come to IMT Nagpur on a student visa. IMT will send a letter of admission as soon as the nominations are received from the respective institute and it will be the responsibility of the incoming exchange students to comply with any Visa or other regulatory requirements.
