Background

In traditional teaching methods, such as lecturing and PPT presentations, the teacher commands students' attention to his lectures by fully controlling their learning environment. These methods, where students are passive participants, are ineffective in enhancing students' understanding and retention. New teaching and learning methods address the problem of retention and understanding by making students the focal point of the teaching and learning process. Students in such processes are more than equal partners in the teaching process; they co-teach in the supervised and facilitating environment.

The two-day residential faculty development program on participant-centered teaching and Learning is designed by well-trained and experienced faculty of the Institute of Management Technology Nagpur. During these two days, the participants will participate and explore cutting-edge participant-centered learning methods, enhancing their teaching skills and making them confident in adopting these methods in their classrooms.

Program Objectives

- To expose the management and social science faculty to participant-centered teaching and learning methods;
- To equip the participants with cutting-edge teaching-learning methods in their classroom in tune with institutional and industry needs;
- To empower the participants to co-create knowledge relevant to management and other social science fields.

Program Coverage

The FDP will have four sessions of one and a half hours each day as follows:

Day 1

Session 1: Participant-centered teaching & learning: What, why, and how?

Session 2: Case method of teaching and learning

Session 3: Simulation and Games

Session 4: Debriefing

Day 2

Session 1: Preparing for a case discussion class

Session 2: Case discussion by participants: an evaluation

Session 3: Case writing tips & co-creation

Session 4: Feedback

Pedagogy will be a mix of group activities, group presentations, discussions, role plays, simulations, and games.

The FDP is designed for the postgraduate faculty teaching management and other social sciences. Doctoral students aiming to join academics may also attend the FDP.
